Artist Memorandum of Understanding Sanford Brush & Palette Club 2026 Annual Art Show and 4th Annual Bowl and Vessel Show This is an agreement between the Sanford Brush & Palette Club ("SBPC") and the below-named person ("Artist") for participation in the 2026 61st Annual Art Show, and/or the 4th Annual Bowl & Vessel Show. Artist shall comply with the following requirements:

1. Artist will read and adhere to the rules and guidelines described in the SBPC's 2026 Annual Art Show Prospectus, and the 2026 Annual Bowl and Vessel Show Prospectus. The Artist or the artwork that does not comply will not be eligible to participate.
2. Artist's Ethical Standard: Artist is responsible for the legal and ethical integrity of their artwork. Artist understands that an artwork may be rejected by judges if, in the judges' opinions, the artwork appears to be derived from another's art (including copyrighted or public domain works). Artist warrants that his/her work is their own creation and does not plagiarize the work of others, nor infringe upon the copyrights of artists or other entities.
3. Artist understands that this is a judged competition, and the decision(s) of the judges are final.
4. Artist agrees to a 20% commission paid to or withheld by the SBPC based on the invoice sale amount of all the artwork sold, excluding note cards/journals.
5. Artist grants permission to SBPC to take photographs of artwork and use them and his/her name for promotional activities, marketing materials and on websites belonging to the SBPC.
6. Artist understands that the SBPC cannot insure artwork or equipment or be responsible for any damage, loss, or theft.
7. Artist will be responsible for the delivery of artwork to and from the event site in a timely manner. Artist may select a proxy to pick up unsold (and sold but undelivered) artwork at the designated time following the close of the show. If work is not picked up, the artist has five (5) days to communicate with the Art Show Chair/Vice Chair with their intended disbursement plans. If efforts have been made and failed to communicate, the artist has 30 days from the end of the event to pick up artwork. If not picked up on the 31st day, it becomes the property of the SBPC.
